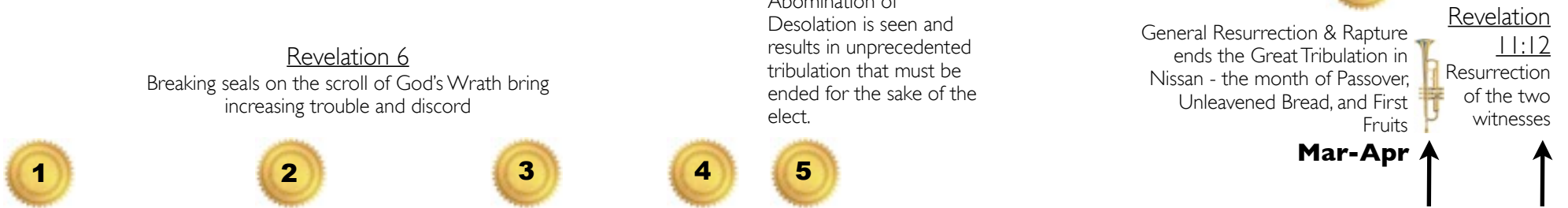

Matthew 24:15-26

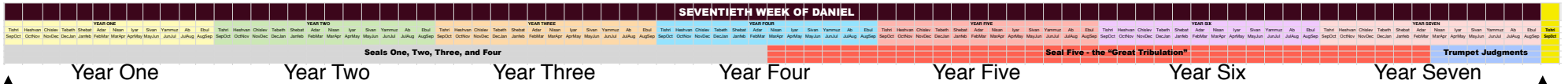
The Great Tribulation begins when the Abomination of Desolation is seen and results in unprecedented tribulation that must be ended for the sake of the elect.

General Resurrection & Rapture ends the Great Tribulation in Nissan - the month of Passover; Unleavened Bread, and First Fruits

Covenant activates Jewish Temple worship on Rosh Hashanah

Covenant Broken by Antichrist on Passover - Abomination of Desolation



Mar-Apr

Matthew 24:32-35; Luke 21:29-36

The Temple and its services ("Fig Tree") signals the dawn of the end times.

Daniel 9:27

The Antichrist's covenant with the many allows Israel to begin her Temple worship but also signals the beginning of the 70th Week of Daniel

2 Thessalonians 2:3, 4

The Antichrist takes his seat in the Temple and say's he's God -- the Abomination of Desolation -- during the Passover month

Daniel 9:27

Antichrist breaks the covenant in the middle of the seven year and ends the Temple worship.

Christ claims the kingdom of the world as the kingdom of our Lord, beginning His earthly reign at the Seventh Trumpet, blown on Rosh Hashanah

1 Corinthians 15:51-57

Resurrection and Rapture " began with the first trumpet, in Nissan, and ended at the last trumpet", which was blown in Tishri, the 7th month of the Sacred Year.
